The Jersey Cow

It has been proven beyond doubt by Scientific Investigation that on a given amount of feed, no other breed of cow is capable of returning as large a yield of Butterfat and still maintaining her body upkeep. The Jersey cow must have the correct “Dairy Temperament” she must therefore have the “will to work” and the “will to give”. Jerseys produce more butterfat and protein per litre of milk and are more efficient and profitable than any other breed because more can be stocked per hectare of pasture.

Jerseys convert 18 per cent more feed per kilogram of live weight than any other breed and produce 13 per cent more milk solids per hectare.

The adaptability of the jersey to a variety of different environments ensures that the breed will thrive in climates where other Dairy Breeds struggle.

Jersey milk has a rich, smooth flavor because it naturally contains higher percentages of protein, calcium and other important nutrients than milk from other dairy breeds.

The Jersey is the most efficient dairy producer in the world, producing more pounds of milk per pound of body weight than any other breed. An average jersey produces 16 times her body weight in milk each year.



Christmas Recipe

Indulgent Pudding

Preparation Time: 30 minutes (plus soaking overnight)

Cooking Time: 1¼ hours for small puddings or 5 hours for large pudding

Serves: 10 — 12

Ingredients

500g Sunbeam Mixed Fruit
375g Sunbeam Raisins
200g Sunbeam Currents
200g Angas Park Fruit Medley
375g Angas Park Dried Peaches, chopped
225g Jellied cranberry sauce
1 cup brandy
1 tsp nutmeg
2 tsp mixed spice
1 tbs. cinnamon, ground
4 eggs, lightly beaten
250g butter, melted and cooled
1 cup dark brown sugar, firmly packed
1½ cups plain flour
½ cup self raising flour
Kitchen string for tying



1. Combine fruit, jellied cranberry sauce, brandy and spices in a large bowl, cover and leave to stand overnight.
2. Brush ten 1— cup pudding basins (ramekins) or one 10— cup basin with melted butter and line base with baking paper.
3. Mix eggs, butter, brown sugar and flours until well combined, then stir through fruit mixture. Spoon mixture into prepared basins.
4. Cut a large circle of foil and baking paper and place over each pudding, foil side up. Secure tightly with kitchen string.
5. Place pudding in a large saucepan and add enough boiling water to fill halfway up the sides. Cover and bring to the boil, reduce heat and cook for 1¼ hours for small puddings or 5 hours for large pudding, replenishing water when needed.
6. Remove from water and store well wrapped until Christmas.





The weather was good and a lot of spectators looked on, the Champion bull was won by P & K Smith of Maraglen Jerseys, Champion Juvenile heifer was won by A & J Higgins of Erindale Jerseys and Reserve Juvenile heifer won by P & K Smith of Maraglen. Champion Intermediate heifer was A & J Higgins and Reserve by P & K Smith, Senior Champion cow was won by N & J McDonald of Sunshine Farm Jerseys and Reserve by A & J Higgins. The Daviesway OFC was again very well supported and this years Champion and Reserve was won by the Parson Family of the Ardley Jersey herd, all results in this bulletin.

This year I had the opportunity to go over to the UK and had a very nice time, although the weather was not so good, when in NTH Ireland I went to visit a friend who owned the Coleraine Jersey herd, and I can remember her and her late husband showing Jerseys at the Coleraine show. Mrs King is now well in her 80's and is still as interested as ever in the Jerseys.

I also had a chance to go to see the Potterswalls Herd of Jerseys owned by the Fleming Family near Downpatrick Co down in NTH Ireland. Ashley has judge here in Australia a couple of times, in 2009 he judged the Jerseys and at a later year he judged the Illawara's. The Fleming family have got a very nice herd of Jerseys, and Ashley's father told me that some of their original cows were purchased from the Coleraine Jersey herd owned by the King family. It was great to see so many good cows and were have been told that they are some of the best Jerseys in the UK. Ardlay Jersey Stud

2015—2016 saw the cows endure one of the driest spring summers followed by one of the wettest winters since the stud began in 1984. We've had two summers and two winters. In 2015 the spring was hot and harvest finished early, silage and hay was hardly stacked away and it was being fed back out. Production was only down 4698 litres on the year before and milk from the cows had bred 156 calves compared to 131 calves in 2014—15. The 2015—16 year saw the herd's total protein for the year drop by 810 kilograms compared to the previous year but the cows went onto break their Butterfat record, by 26 kilograms. June was a good month with good weather, season was going well, which saw the herd break that months record for milk produced with the highest butterfat and protein solids produced in any June. But from July onwards it rained and didn't stop, winter came and went, spring followed and it was still raining. Twenty nine and half inches of rain has fallen since the cows started calving in May and the weather had not helped with the cow's production. This has a bad effect on not only our herd but all herds supplying the local factory. Production from July to October has seen the cows drop by 10,073 litres a drop of 1,266 kilograms of butterfat but an increase of 534 kilograms of protein. This year 2 year old daughters in milk sired by Ardlay Super Trooper who is the son of Ardlay HR Troubador (sire Ardlay Hasty Red he is double bred to Hasty River Roslyn, his Dam Ardlay Sweetrose 12 VHC was sired by Ivanhoe Red Triumph and she is a granddaughter of Winrae Beacons Sweetrose 14 VHC 92). Troubador is also the maternal grandsire of the 3 year old in milk winner Ardlay Jupiter's Bluemist in the On Farm Challenge 2016. Daughters in milk sired by Ardlay Hollow Jovial (Sire Big Hollow Jovial Pioneer, Dam Ardlay Twylight Confetti VHC, daughter of Hasty River Twylight Red) Confetti was a great production cow with the best temperament a beautiful cow to milk. Jovial has passed this temperament onto his daughters they also have beautiful heads with good jaws and square muzzles, good milkers.

In March we purchased the farm next to our other farm at Ayresford, 12 kilometers north of the home farm. This farm came with a herd of Holstein cows. During the hot summer we had to feed 35 springing Holsteins and they would consume as much feed as 112 Springing jersey heifers. We were able to sell half the Holstein herd and we purchased 51 jersey heifers from the Ballangeich Jersey Stud (Ballangee). These heifers included 29 daughters of Cairnbrae Jaces Elton, 11 Cairnbrae Maxamillion, 5 Claydon Park Flower Power, 3 Nowell Sandblast and 3 Ferdon Choice Harvest. David (son) and Katrina are milking on the second farm and the cows were all Black and White at the start and this herd would out produce the home farm by 68,925 litres from March to June but the home farm (with sons, Sam and Daniel) herd would out produce in solids.

On Farm Challenge 2016 saw the stud win Champion Cow and Best Vessel with Ardlay Grandious Lynette VHC, her dam is Ardlay Choice Lynette 2EXC CP 4 (granddaughter of Ferdon Choice Harvest). Lynette 2 has won Best Vessel in previous On Farm Challenge, has also bred three daughters, who have each won a Best Vessel award in 2014, 2015 and 2016. Grandious Lynette is sired by Rapid Bay Grandious whose dam is Vandenberg Amedeo Gorgeous. Gorgeous is also the dam of Rapid Bay Grand Prix and Yellow Briar Heath's Gaupo and he is the sire of Reserve Champion cow and second best vessel winner, Ardlay Gaupo's Lynette, daughter of last year's Reserve Champion cow Red Lynette. Gaupo's Lynette is also granddaughter of Choice Lynette 2. The winning group of three are all granddaughters of Vandenberg Amedeo Gorgeous, two daughters of Grandious and one of Y B H Gaupo. The winning three year old cow Jupiter's Bluemist is a daughter of Ardlay Grand Prix Jupiter sired by Rapid Bay Grand Prix and his dam Bosses Junette is a daughter of Linmore Zebs Boss. Linmore Zebs Boss would also appear in Bluemist's maternal side. Zebs Boss would leave progeny with very good udders, high Butterfat and Protein tests, he was the paternal grand sire of Sweetrose 74 HC 92, 2013 Reserve Champion and 2014 Champion Cow. Herd 365—Highest butterfat 5.96 + Protein 4.25 for October. Pedigree of MacDonnell Tandra Lynette and Ardlay Lynmarks Satin, 2011 OFC Champion Cow.
